Dear Parent /Carer

As part of their Key Stage 3 History Studies on the Industrial Revolution, Year 9 students are being offered the opportunity to visit The Black Country Living Museum. The museum is a re-creation of a Victorian town where students will have the opportunity to undertake such activities as being taught in a Victorian school, going down a mine and purchasing goods from Victorian shops.

If you state on the consent form that your child has an existing medical condition and you believe the trip's itinerary and activity may be detrimental to their condition, you may need to provide a doctor's letter stating that your child is fit to undertake the activities listed.
