



## Icknield Community College School Uniform 2021-22

**Icknield Community College expects all of its students to be smartly and safely dressed. The School Uniform policy will be updated annually.**

### **Black blazer with pre-embroidered school badge (all year round)**

### **White collared shirt with school tie**

- Shirts must be able to be buttoned to the neck
- Coloured or patterned garments worn underneath the shirt should not be visible

### **Black school trousers**

- Black logoed trousers

### **School skirt**

- Black pencil or pleated logoed skirts
- Black and grey tartan pleated skirts

### **Black school shoes or boots**

Shoes and boots should be smart and be completely black with black laces. For health and safety reasons, shoes should have a full back and front and be flat or with only a very low heel. No open-toed shoes

### **Other**

- Clip on ties will be worn in the appropriate colour for each year group
- Logoed black v-neck jumpers may also be worn. No other jumper is acceptable, including plain black v-neck jumpers
- Cardigans are not allowed
- "Hoodies" and sweatshirts are not allowed in school and cannot be worn as coats
- Coats or jackets should be suitable for school wear and should be removed along with hats, gloves and scarves when in the school building or in lessons (unless told otherwise by teachers)
- One pair of earring studs may be worn. These need to be removed for PE, Dance and DT and remain the student's responsibility
- Other piercings are not allowed. Students will be asked to remove any other piercings and replace them with clear retainers if necessary
- A wristwatch and one ring are the only other jewellery allowed
- Extremes of fashion in hair styles are not allowed. If hair is dyed, it must be a single "natural" colour. Please note that if hair is dyed in the holidays it must be washed out or corrected before the start of term
- Make-up must be discreet and natural looking and coloured nail varnish or false nails of any kind are not allowed

**PLEASE NOTE:** At ICC we feel strongly that being smartly dressed sets the tone for excellent learning. If students do not adhere to this policy, they will be asked to correct their uniform. If the problem persists then further sanctions, including isolation from normal lessons may be applied until the issue is resolved.

## **Physical Education**

### **Compulsory Items**

#### **Long sleeved sports top**

- Logoed black and red reversible

#### **Sports polo top**

- Logoed black and red short sleeve top

#### **Skort or Shorts**

- Plain black with no visible brand names or logos. Shorts should be loose fitting and give good coverage

#### **Socks**

- Sports ankle socks
- Football style socks that can support a shin-pad

#### **Studded boots**

#### **Trainers**

- Suitable for sport with non-marking soles. No plimsoles

#### **Shin pads**

#### **Mouth guard**

- Must be moulded at home prior to lessons

### **Optional Items**

#### **Leggings**

- Plain black sports leggings with no visible brand names or logos. Leggings must be nylon or lycra rather than cotton

#### **PE Hoodie**

- Logoed black and red hoodie

#### **Tracksuit bottoms**

- Completely black tracksuit bottoms with no other obvious markings

#### **Thermal top**

- Plain black or white thermal top to be worn underneath sports top

**All logoed items can be bought from TRUTEX. Other non-logoed sports items can be purchased from TRUTEX or other sports retailers or suppliers. Ties are sold from the school finance office only.**
